Irth App Project Operations Internship (Maternal Health Tech Non-profit)

About Narrative Nation Inc, Irth App:

Irth is a project of Narrative Nation, a New York-based 501(c)(3), that creates narrative-centered media and technology to address health disparities. Narrative Nation is a tech non-profit that champions health equity by democratizing the story of inequities to foster systemic change and catalyze behavioral shifts.

Irth (as in Birth, but we dropped the B for bias) is the first-of-its-kind review and recommendation engine designed for Black and brown women and birthing people to find and leave reviews of Ob/GYNs, birthing hospitals, and pediatricians. The app builds community with a platform for local crowd-sourced peer reviews, while driving transparency and accountability within health systems. On the back end, Irth turns its structured reviews into detailed Black patient experience data, strategic insights, and hospital improvement plans to help health systems “learn from the living” to provide more respectful and equitable care.

Job Summary:
